



# **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

### TRUSTEES REPORT

- Repairs from the water damage are complete. We have signed off on the final walk through. Once the insurance claim is closed, Philadelphia Insurance will send us the final payout.
- Philadelphia Insurance dropped our property insurance coverage as of August 14 but is continuing to cover our liability insurance. We have contracted with The Lords of London Insurance for property coverage.
- The faulty valve in the fire suppression system has been replaced and is holding pressure. The nitrogen system has been turned back on.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

NET OPERATING INCOME	- \$3,000
Operating Expenses	\$33,000
UNRESTRICTED INCOME	\$30,000
Non-Pledged	\$5,000
Pledged	\$25 <i>,</i> 000

- YTD income \$184,000 vs. unrestricted expenses of \$261,000 = <u>deficit of \$77,000</u>.
- The overage in expenses is due to church building and grounds maintenance costs being well over budget once again (+34K)

#### SEPTEMBER - West With Giraffes by Lynda Rutledge

An emotional, rousing novel inspired by the incredible true story of two giraffes who made headlines and won the hearts of Depression-Era America.

Woodrow Wilson Nickel age 105, feels his life ebbing away. But when he learns giraffes are going extinct, he finds himself recalling the unforgettable experience he cannot take to his grave.

It's 1938. The Great Depression lingers. Hitler is threatening Europe, and world-weary Americans long for wonder. They find it in two giraffes who miraculously survive a hurricane while crossing the Atlantic. What follows is a twelve-day road trip in a custom truck to deliver Southem California's first giraffes to the San Diego Zoo. Behind the wheel is the young Dust Bowl rowdy Woodrow. Inspired by true events, the tale weaves real-life figures with fictional ones, including the world's first female zoo director, a crusty old man with a past, a young female photographer with a secret, and assorted reprobates as spotty as the giraffes.


