



NET OPERATING	\$10.000 GAIN
Operating Expenses	\$32,000
UNRESTRICTED INCOME	\$42,000
Non-Pledged	\$20,000
Pledged	\$22,000

- YTD income \$406,000 vs. unrestricted expenses of \$438,000 = <u>\$32,000 operating</u> loss for the year to date.
- The overage in expenses is due to church building and grounds maintenance costs being well over budget (+\$57K)

FEBRUARY: THE LITTLE LIAR by Mitch Albon

Beloved bestselling author Mitch Albon returns with a powerful novel of hope and forgiveness that moves from a coastal Greek city during World War II to America in the golden age of Hollywood, as the intertwined lives of three young survivors are forever change by the perils of deception and the grace of redemption.

Eleven-year-old Nico Krispis has never told a lie. His schoolmate Fannie loves him because of it. Nico^ts older brother Sebastian resents him for both of these facts. When their young lives are torn apart during the war, it will take them decades to find each other again.
